Bible Study Questions

(September 15-21, 2013)

- 1. (Luke 5:1-11)** What is the new job description Jesus gives to Peter?
- 2. (Matthew 4:18-22)** Does every Christian receive a similar call from Jesus? If yes, explain how?
- 3. (John 1:40-42)** What did Andrew do first after he became a follower of Jesus? Is there any thing we may learn from his example?
- 4. (Mark 2:13-14)** Why do you think Jesus called Levi to be one of his disciples?
- 5. (1 Samuel 3:1-14)** Think about God’s call to Samuel and what is said about Eli. Relate this to the church and the work each of us is called to do. What comparison do you see?
- 6. (Acts 16:11-15)** How is Lydia’s calling like all of our callings? What role does Lydia immediately perform?
- 7. (Acts 16:1-5)** Timothy’s circumcision was done so he could better fit in and be accepted as a Jewish Christian missionary. Think about other things we each may need to do in order to be missionaries to our friends, relatives, acquaintances and neighbors. Name some.
