Bible Study Questions

(September 22-28, 2013)

- 1. (Isaiah 50:4)** Consider the theme “Called to be Servants” what would you expect God to do for you if you will make this part of your daily prayers?
- 2. (Matthew 3:13-17)** Again considering our theme, what would be the similarities in our baptisms and Jesus’ baptism?
- 3. (2 Kings 17:35-41)** Verse 35 says “*Do not worship any other gods or bow down to them, serve them or sacrifice to them.*” What would qualify as “other gods” today? How would these “other gods” be served or sacrificed to?
- 4. (Mark 9:2-8)** How can you and I “listen to Jesus” today?
- 5. (Matthew 26:36-46)** What principle do we learn in this passage that is the proper response by the true servant of God?
- 6. (James 1:19)** How far and to whom does this verse extend?
- 7. (Isaiah 49:1-6)** Have you ever said what the servant says in verse 4? What brought you back to the realization that the servant does in the last part of the verse?
