Bible Study Questions

(October 6-12, 2013)

- 1. (Mark 4:35-41)** What do you think Jesus is showing the disciples about himself in this passage?
- 2. (Matthew 14:22-33)** In this “training exercise” what is the lesson Jesus is teaching his disciples and us?
- 3. (John 8:1-11)** In Jesus’ response to the woman what do you think his tone of voice was and what fundamentals of Christian faith do you see at work here?
- 4. (Psalm 46:10)** How do you think this speaks to us Christians in the contemporary society we live in?
- 5. (Isaiah 53:4-5)** What was misunderstood about the servant? What did the servant really do?
- 6. (Micah 5:4-5)** According to the first part of verse 5 who will be the people’s peace? (See Eph. 2:14 as well) Considering the meaning of these verses why do you think we may lack peace?
- 7. (Galatians 5:22)** Why can’t peace or any of the other elements mentioned here be manufactured?
