Bible Study Questions
(October 20-26, 2013)

1. **(John 4:1-14)** What did Jesus say would be the result of drinking the water He offered?

2. **(John 4:1-6)** As someone taught from birth to detest Samaritans, how would you have felt when Jesus decided to go through Samaria instead of the regular route? What, if any, contemporary analogies like this can you think of?

3. **(John 4:7-15)** How does the “give me a drink” (vs.7) and “give me this water” (vs. 15) fulfill our theme “called to be servants?”

4. **(John 4:16-26)** Do you think there is any significance to Jesus revealing himself as the Messiah to this woman? What, if any?

5. **(John 4:27-30)** What impact does Jesus revelation of himself as Messiah have on this woman?

6. **(John 4:31-38)** What does Jesus say that reveals the heart of the ideal supreme servant of God?

7. **(John 4:39-42)** Think about question #2 again. How would you have felt about spending two days with the Samaritans? Do you think the disciples stayed too? What do these verses teach you about Jesus?
