<b>5.</b> ( <b>Matthew 22:1-10</b> ) What is the primary thing for the king's servants to do in this passage?
<b>6.</b> (Matthew 13:44-45) What do these parables teach us about the value of the kingdom of God?
7. (Revelation 21:1-7) How did the voice describe the new world to come?
