Bible Study Questions
(November 24 - 30, 2013)

- 1. (Revelation 7:9-17; John 10:11-17)** Do you find any similarities in the two passages? What are they?

- 2. (Psalm 103:1-5)** Who does David address in these verses?

- 3. (Matthew 5:1-11)** If you had to grade yourself on where you are on the “poor in spirit” scale (1 2 3 4 5 [1 being the lowest and 5 being the highest]) where would you be? Why did you place yourself there? Where would Jesus place you? Where would others place you?

- 4. (2 Corinthians 2:14-17)** How can the same gospel be the smell of death or the fragrance of life?

- 5. (Matthew 6:5-15)** Why do you think Jesus says what he says about forgiveness in verses 14-15 when he had said “this is how you should pray” in verse 9?

- 6. (Psalm 23)** How many different things can you name that would make up the relationship a shepherd of that day would have had with his sheep (think about duties, time, care, etc.). Does this help you to see what David meant when he said, “The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not want.”?

- 7. (Revelation 19:1-8)** What is the recurring word of praise used in this passage and how was it being said? From that word and how it is being said, what do you think about the atmosphere around the throne?
